Issues I am concerned about:

- 1) PROVIDING FOR OUR COMMUNITY Growth is not preordained, and I do not agree with the "if you don't grow you will die" developer mentality. Rigid APFO's (Adequate Public Facility Ordinances) have been adopted to protect our town and the surrounding areas. Water, sewer, schools and emergency response services (fire, rescue, police, etc.) are all necessary infrastructure that must to be in place prior to consideration of arowth.
- 2) PRESERVING OUR FARMLAND Proper land use management i.e. maintaining the agricultural nature of the land around Walkersville, and not allowing it to become diluted by nonagricultural uses is paramount in ensuring our rural nature remains intact, and our infrastructure will not be further strained, if not overwhelmed. I will work to keep our Greenbelt Green!
- 3) PROTECTING OUR CITIZENS Ensuring that our Resident State Troopers and the Frederick County Police are actively working for our citizens' best interests. Much of America is reeling from a rampant Opioid and prescription drug crisis, and Walkersville has seen its share. We need to remain vigilant.
- 4) **BUSINESS RECOGNITION** Recognizing and bringing more business into Walkersville. The Town needs to do more to promote, retain and develop increased business in Walkersville. and that starts with providing a business-friendly atmosphere.
